What is the Seal of Biliteracy?

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given by a school, district or state in recognition of students who have attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation.

*How do students obtain the Seal of Biliteracy?**

Language proficiency in both English and another language will be tested through an approved test. In the non-English language, students must obtain an Intermediate Mid proficiency level in order to be eligible for the Seal of Biliteracy. Students earning a Advanced Low proficiency may earn an 'Advanced Distinction'.

Who benefits?

- Students in a well articulated Dual Language Immersion program
- Students who are Heritage and / or Native speakers.
- Students who have taken advanced language courses.

What does the Seal of Biliteracy mean for a student's future?

Employers are looking for linguistically competent employees who can handle a variety of situations in English and another language.

At the university level students may be placed in more advanced coursework, working towards a major or minor more quickly.
